### Community of Christ Church

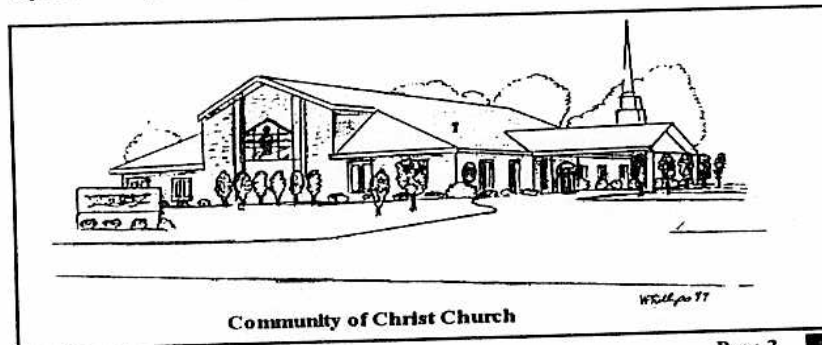

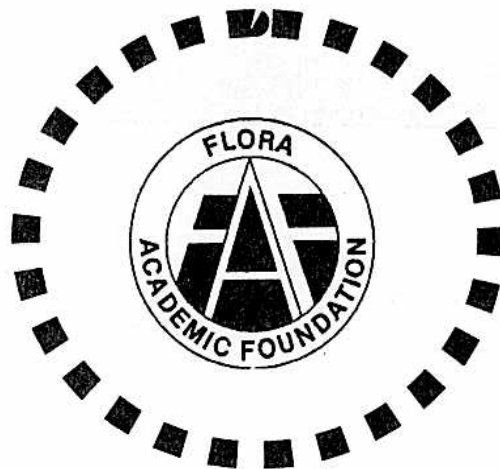
