

**Fall 2006 Brush Creek Mission Center Minutes**  
**October 1, 2006**

The Brush Creek Mission Center met in regular conference on October 1, 2006 for the Fall Conference at the Brush Creek Campgrounds. At the beginning of conference, the conference viewed a video about the 2007 World Conference. Brother John Etcheson welcomed the conference, then Sister Chris Ober read a scripture. The conference then sang two hymns, "As We Gather" NS 3 and "Shine, Jesus, Shine" NS 45. Sister Ober brought the invocation.

Mission Center President then called the meeting to order. Attention was first turned to the 2006 Spring Conference minutes. David Savage moved to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded and carried by vote.

Brother Chuck Knapp took the chair. He called attention to the letter in the bulletin from President Steve Veazey recommending that John Etcheson be sustained as the Brush Creek Mission Center President. Dale Warren made the motion to sustain John Etcheson as president. The motion was seconded and carried by vote. Brother Keenan explained the report and accepted questions. Karen Switzer made the motion to approve the report. The motion was seconded and carried by vote.

Attention was then turned to the Mission Center Appointments. Priscilla Henson made the motion to sustain Sam Lambert, Stan Morrison, and Christine Ober to the Campground Endowment Committee with each term expiring in 2008. The motion was seconded and carried by vote.

Dale Warren then made the motion to sustain several positions. The motion was seconded. Each position was voted on separately with the following being approved: Bridges Editor – Joyce Keenan; Conference Secretary – Tammy Austin; Historian – Lou

Oliver; Missionary Coordinator – Brad Bryant; Mission Center Recorder – Tammy Austin; SPEC Coordinator – Tammy Austin; Temple School Coordinator – Luray MacArthur; Youth Camp Director – Mike Hodge; Youth/Young Adult Director – Josh Zettler; and Web Communications – Brad Bryant.

Attention was then turned to sustaining officers on the Brush Creek Campground Board. Steve Cooley made the motion to sustain Dale Warren as the president of the board. The motion was seconded and carried by vote. Cleo Anderson made the motion to sustain Bill Knapp as the treasurer of the board. The motion was seconded and carried by vote.

Stan Morrison made the motion to sustain the following on the Brush Creek Youth Camp Committee: Mike Hodge, Emily Putbrese, Keith Rhine, John Bunnell, Cindy Halley, and Todd Halley. The motion was seconded and carried by vote.

Nancy Kemp made the motion to sustain the following on the Mission Center Council: Doug Mack, Cliff McIntosh, Daniel Collins, Karen Witts, Megan Pierce, David Patton, Jean Rumble, Andrea Collins, David MacArthur, Kitty Martin, and Angie Burkett. The motion was seconded and carried by vote.

Attention was then turned to the 2007 Brush Creek Mission Center Budget. Marvin Kleinau made the motion to approve the budget. The motion was seconded. Discussion followed. The motion was voted on and carried.

At this point, Donna Bryant and Garry Rockett brought offertory remarks to the conference. An offering was received.

Fred Keenan then presided over the election of the Ministry Endowment Fund Committee. Fred Keenan made the motion that the following be elected with their terms expiring on December 31, 2008: Wayne Welborn, Ray Sills, Ernest Rumble, Brittany Longsdorf, and Tammy Austin. The motion was seconded and carried by vote.

Attention was then turned to election for the Brush Creek Campground Board. Marlene McIntosh and Phil Rogers were elected to serve on the campground board with a term expiring December 31, 2009. David Patton was elected to fill the remainder of a term with his term expiring December 31, 2008.

Attention was then turned to election of delegates to the 2007 World Conference. Cathy Colarusso and Linda Bundren were elected as alternates.

Attention was then turned to new business. Cleo Anderson made the motion that the new lodge be named in recognition of the Dr. Don Bunnell. The motion was seconded. Discussion followed. Brad Bryant then made the motion to refer the topic of recognition of Dr. Bunnell to the campground committee. The motion was seconded. Discussion again followed. The motion was voted on and carried.

In other remarks, Marion Harmon mentioned that the RV Association made additions to the Brush Creek Campgrounds this summer, and they hope to return next summer.

Darrell Walker made the motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded and carried by vote.

Following closing remarks by John Etcheson, Richard Streibich brought a Mission Center Blessing. The conference sang "Companions of the Journey" NS7, and Richard Switzer brought the prayer of benediction.
